Simple steps to follow for your interview



Step 1: Research the company

• Who are they? • What do they do? • What are their values? Browse their website and social media channels to find out about their long term goals and internal culture.



Step 2: Prepare common interview questions and answers

• What do you know about us? • What are your strengths and weaknesses? • Describe a difficult situation you managed and what were the outcomes? • Any questions?



Step 3: Dress in a presentable way

Generally, a job interview calls for you to wear professional, or business, attire. See information below for examples of what this might look like.



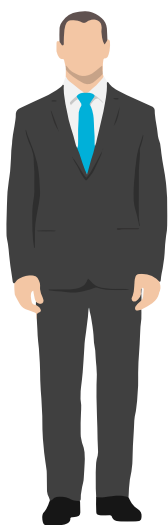
Step 4: Arrive at your interview on time

Arrive on time, preferably 10 minutes early. If unexpected circumstances occur e.g. traffic jam or an emergency, call prior and explain the situation. Do not arrive late!
